*Dear Parents and Learners*

Please take note of the following:

## GRADE 4 - 7 EXAMS

Grade 7 learners will start writing mid-year examinations from 13 May - 31 May 2019.

Grades 4 - 6 learners will start from 15 May - 31 May 2019.

- School will end at 13h00 every day from 13 May to 31 May for grades R to 7.
- No extra-mural activities (EXCEPT Experi-buddies and Playball) will take place during exam time.
- Extra-mural activities will resume on Monday, 03 June.
- From Monday, 03 June we will resume our normal school hours, i.e. 14h15 Monday to Thursday and 13h00 on a Friday.

PLEASE NOTE:
